 heaven and earth are full of your glory.**

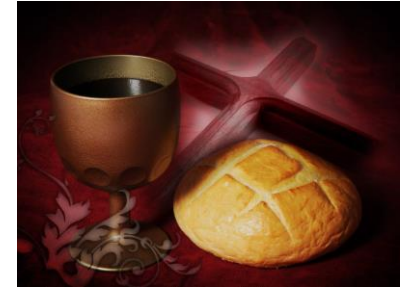
