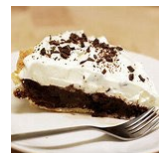

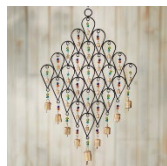

It has a hanging loop and measures 8"h x 6"w x 8"d.
