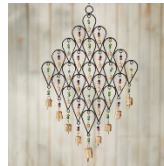

Our Basket Birdhouse from the Philippines is made from sustainably harvested woods and fibers, is densely constructed and finished with rustic details. It has a hanging loop and measures 8"h x 6"w x 8"d.
